

Morris Area Genealogy Society  
Executive Board Meeting  
September 9, 1991

The meeting was called to order by Diane Dellicker, President, at 7:30 pm. Eugene Caprio, Treasurer, reported a balance of \$2940.62 in the treasury.

Diane said that we need a new Interest Group Coordinator and a new Activities Coordinator, and that she will ask at the General Meeting for volunteers.

We are looking for a new printer for the newsletter. The previous printer raised the price from \$.30 to \$.75 per copy. For this price we supply the paper. John Ware said that he will look into the prices at other printing shops and at the possibility of photocopying it. We need four 11x17 sheets printed on both sides.

Joan Armour reported that the speakers for May and November will be reversed. The September speaker will be John Celardo instead of Greg Pfunges. The topic will be the same. Concerning the Seminar, Joan said that we have 27 reservations. She will put applications on each chair at the next membership meeting. Janice Nusbaum will take some to the NYU Family History Fair. It is on October 13 and we can still have a table there if someone is willing to sit at it.

The Board agreed to give \$25 to the National Archives Gift Fund.

Diane has learned that park rules forbid money changing hands at Lewis Morris Park. The fee for use of the park is \$40 plus some extras. John Ware moved that we take the money out of the treasury to cover the park fees.

Only one person has expressed interest in the National Genealogical Study Course.

Under new business, Diane said that the library's amplification system no longer works and we will have none for the next meeting. Judy Weinstein said she could bring the one from the Parsippany Library for that meeting. Diane and Judy will look into getting one for the society to use and store in the Local History Room.

Diane Chang asked if the Society could make its donation to the Local History Room earlier so that she could buy the 1920 New Jersey Census as soon as it comes out.

We have run out of the salmon colored paper for our flyers and it is no longer available. There was some discussion of what color to use when our supply runs out.

Diane said that she will get out the new membership lists as

soon as they are ready. She suggested that the Interest Group Chair should be a member of the Board. After some discussion, it was decided to leave membership of the Board as it is.

Jan Huth said that the library needs photos of a group meeting at the library. The Board agreed to our group having its photo taken.

Diane announced that Joyce Oshrin may be selected to be on Alex Haley's program.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm
